My recent Engagements

- I joined the Royal Navy fresh from my BSc in mathematics at Manchester University. During my 12-year naval career as an operations officer, I developed and studied leadership closely, served in war zones on many occasions, and served as Deputy Chief of Staff in the UK deployed maritime force, running the battle.
- After gaining an MBA at INSEAD in 2000, I joined the London office of McKinsey & Company, working there for five years.
- In 2006 I founded my own organizational behavior consulting firm, which has grown into a practice with 3 partners and 30 associates. In 2012 I co-founded Aberkyn with four partner colleagues and with McKinsey.

I live in Winchester, England with my wife Clare and my four (increasingly adult) children.
