- "How must the HR-function evolve to drive human capacity and organizational capabilities for innovation, talent development, and strategic resilience?"
- "What is required to develop next-era leadership and how will AI impact the future of work and leadership in this next era?"

The People Leader Track will be fully integrated into the Forum Program on November 6 & 7. Additionally, on the Pre-Conference Day on November 5, CHROs have the opportunity to exchange ideas in dedicated masterclasses with world-class thought leaders.
